

Thanks for Participating in Hub on Wheels.

We look forward to seeing you on Sunday, Sept. 23 at City Hall Plaza.
Here are a few bits of information that will make your day easier.

Getting to City Hall Plaza.

- **Address** 1 City Hall Square, Boston, MA 02108.
- **Alternative transportation**
 - Government Center, Haymarket and State are the closest T stops. Bikes allowed on Sundays on all T, commuter and bus lines except green and silver.
- **Park for \$3 at Government Center Garage**
 - Details and directions are on coupon in registration packets
- **Watch out for Road Closures**
 - If you drive, note that Court St. and Cambridge St. (west-bound) will be closed .

When you Arrive

- **Head straight to the start queue if you have your number**
 - No need to wait in line at registration or get caught in traffic on the Plaza.
- **Arrive by 7:15 am**
 - The ride starts promptly at 8:00 am and we cannot allow late starters due to restrictions on the Storrow Drive closure.
- **Wear your number**
 - Your number is your ticket to the ride and festival. You must wear it.

Riding Hub on Wheels

- **This is a RIDE, not a RACE**
- **Many roads are open to traffic**
 - All rules of the road apply. Please be careful.
 - Some roads are rough and/or unpaved. Hybrid or mountain bikes are recommended.
- **Wear a helmet**
- **Children must be 12 years or older to ride**
 - Children under 12 may participate only if accompanied by an adult on a tandem, trail-a-bike or trailer. Anyone under 18 must be accompanied by an adult.
- **Food**
 - Redbones BBQ lunch is available to purchase after the ride. Vegetarian option available.
 - Water and snacks are provided at all rest stops and the finish.
- **Goodie bags and merchandise can be picked up after the ride**
 - Look for our friendly volunteers handing out goodie bags in the finish chute.
